BE CONTENT - MOVE ON

A poor man was out looking for food for himself and his family. It was cold, and he wore an old, cast off, badly stained overcoat. It looked bad, but kept him fairly warm. Someone asked him if he wouldn't like a better coat? He replied, "No, it's ok" and moved on. There were a lot of things he'd like to have, but he was looking for those things he **needed**. His coat was **sufficient** and he knew it. He needed to move forward to find food for himself and his family. If he hadn't been satisfied with the coat and gone looking for something better, he would have been distracted from looking for the more important things. He and his family would likely go hungry. He had his goal and priorities right.

What's your goal? This world, or the next? Are cares for things of this world distracting you from what you need to be doing in the church, preparing for the next world? That's not what God wants:

> "Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee." - Hebrews 13:5

God wants us to be content with the physical things we have so we'll devote ourselves to growing in Godliness.

> "But godliness with contentment is great gain. For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out. And having food and raiment let us be therewith content." - 1 Timothy 6:6-8
